Strongest winds in long duration High Wind event expected Tuesday

Key Messages

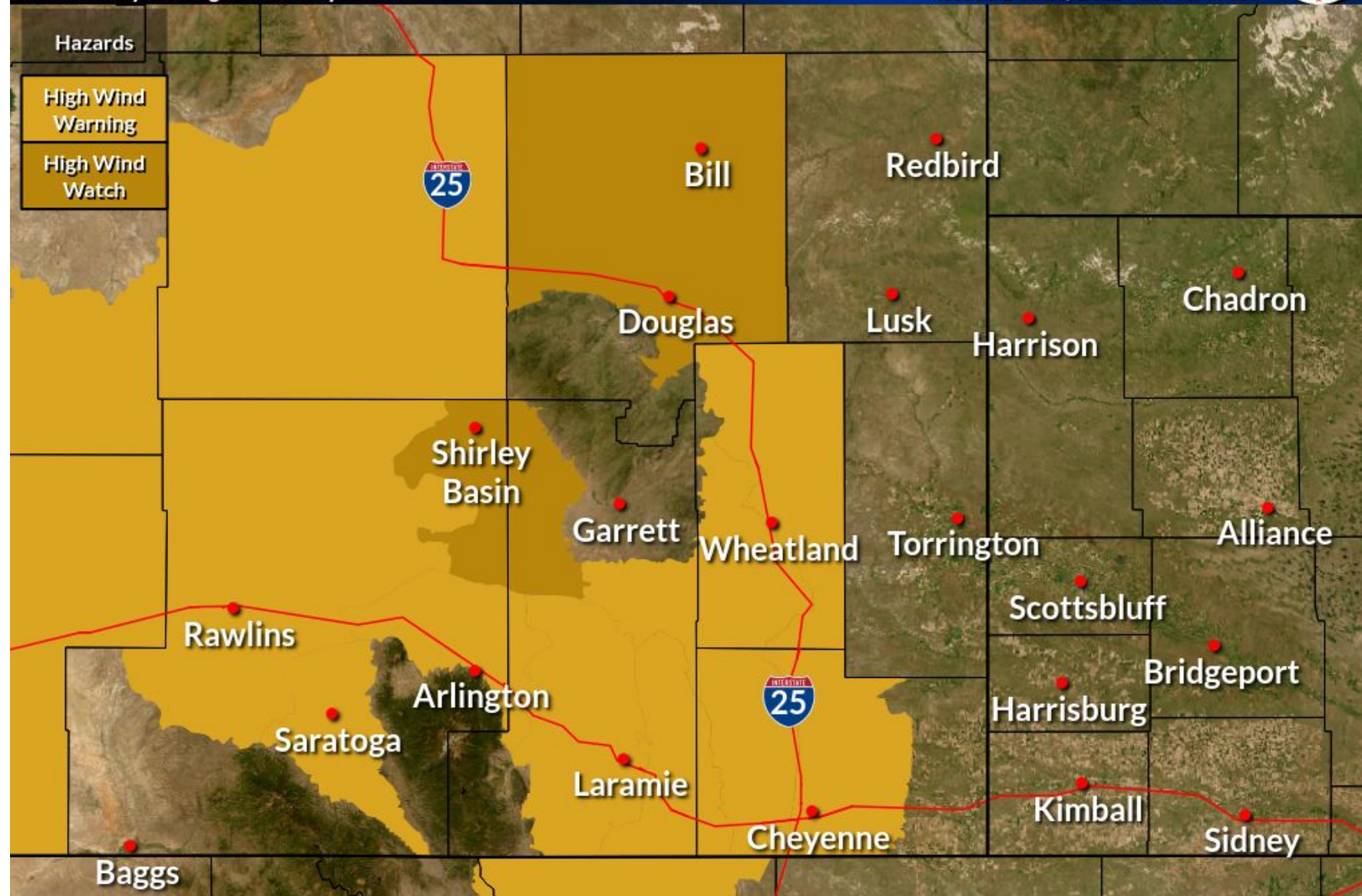
- The break in the strong winds will come to an end from west to east Wednesday mid morning into the early afternoon. This phase will be **mainly confined to southeast Wyoming**.
- **High Wind Warnings** in effect for much of southeast Wyoming along and west of I-25
 - ◆ **Wind Prone Areas:** Until 5AM Fri.
 - ◆ **Carbon/Albany Counties:** 8 AM Wed. - 5PM Thu.
 - ◆ **I-25 Corridor:** Noon Wed. - 5 PM Thu.
- **High Wind Watches** for the Shirley Basin and Converse County where confidence in reaching 60+ mph is lower

Wednesday & Wednesday Night

Key Messages

- **Wind prone areas** (I-25 Bordeaux, I-80 Arlington/Elk Mountain, I-80 Summit) are expected to see gusts **between 65 and 75 mph**. A few gusts exceeding 80 mph are possible.
- **Southeast Wyoming** cities along I-25 and I-80 (Cheyenne, Laramie, Rawlins, and Wheatland) can expect gusts of **55 to 65 mph**. Brief gusts to around 70 mph cannot be ruled out.
- Wednesday's wind will be mainly confined to areas along and west of I-25
- Occasional breaks and lulls are expected, especially overnight.

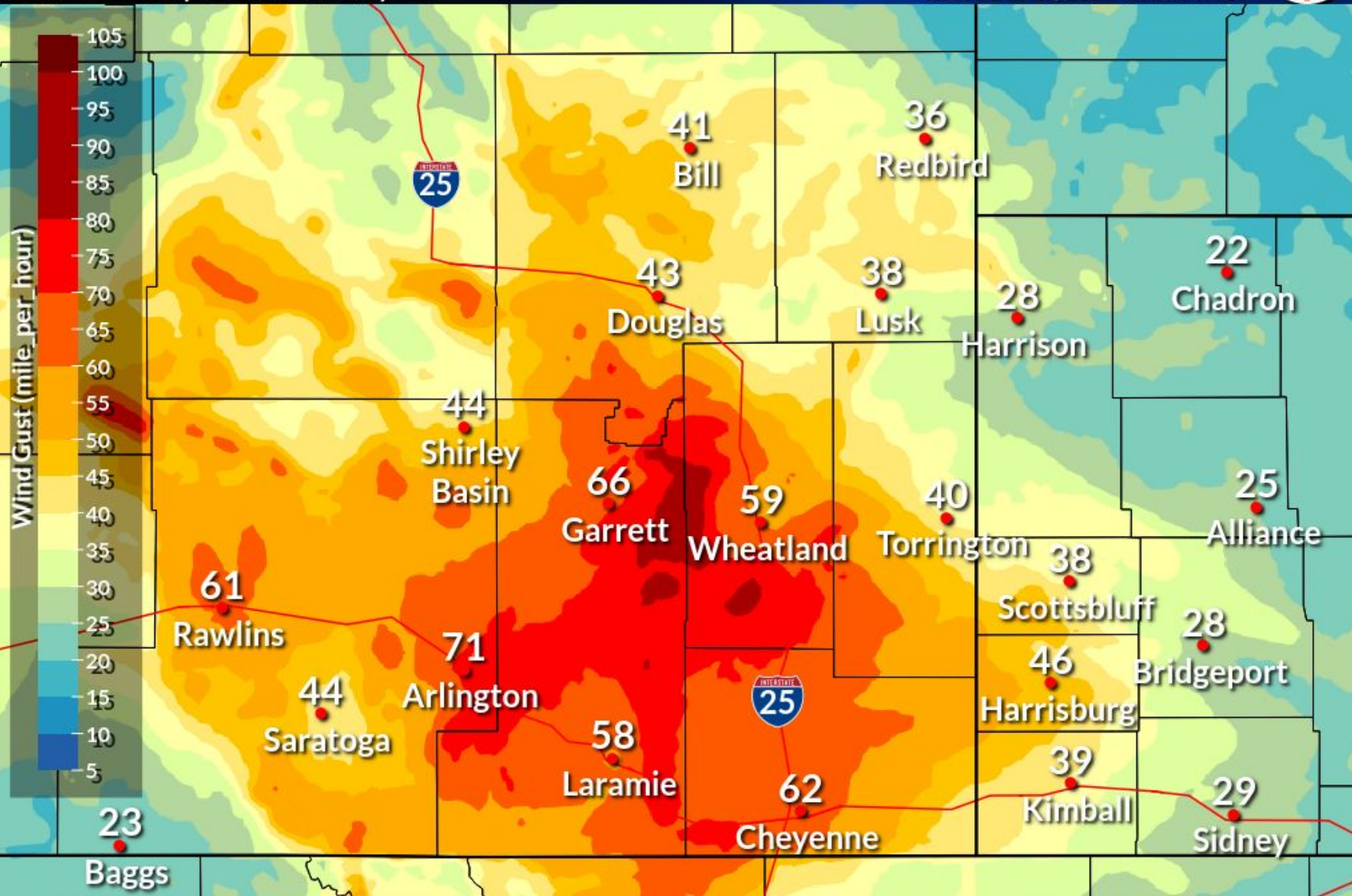

Thursday

Key Messages

- **Wind prone areas** (I-25 Bordeaux, I-80 Arlington/Elk Mountain, I-80 Summit) are expected to see gusts **between 70 and 80 mph**. A few gusts exceeding 85 mph are possible.
- **Southeast Wyoming** cities along I-25 and I-80 (Cheyenne, Laramie, Rawlins, and Wheatland) can expect gusts of **55 to 65 mph**. Brief gusts to around 70 mph cannot be ruled out.
- Thursday's wind may spread into the rest of southeast Wyoming and the western Nebraska panhandle, but confidence is lower there.
- Winds will finally decrease Thursday evening.

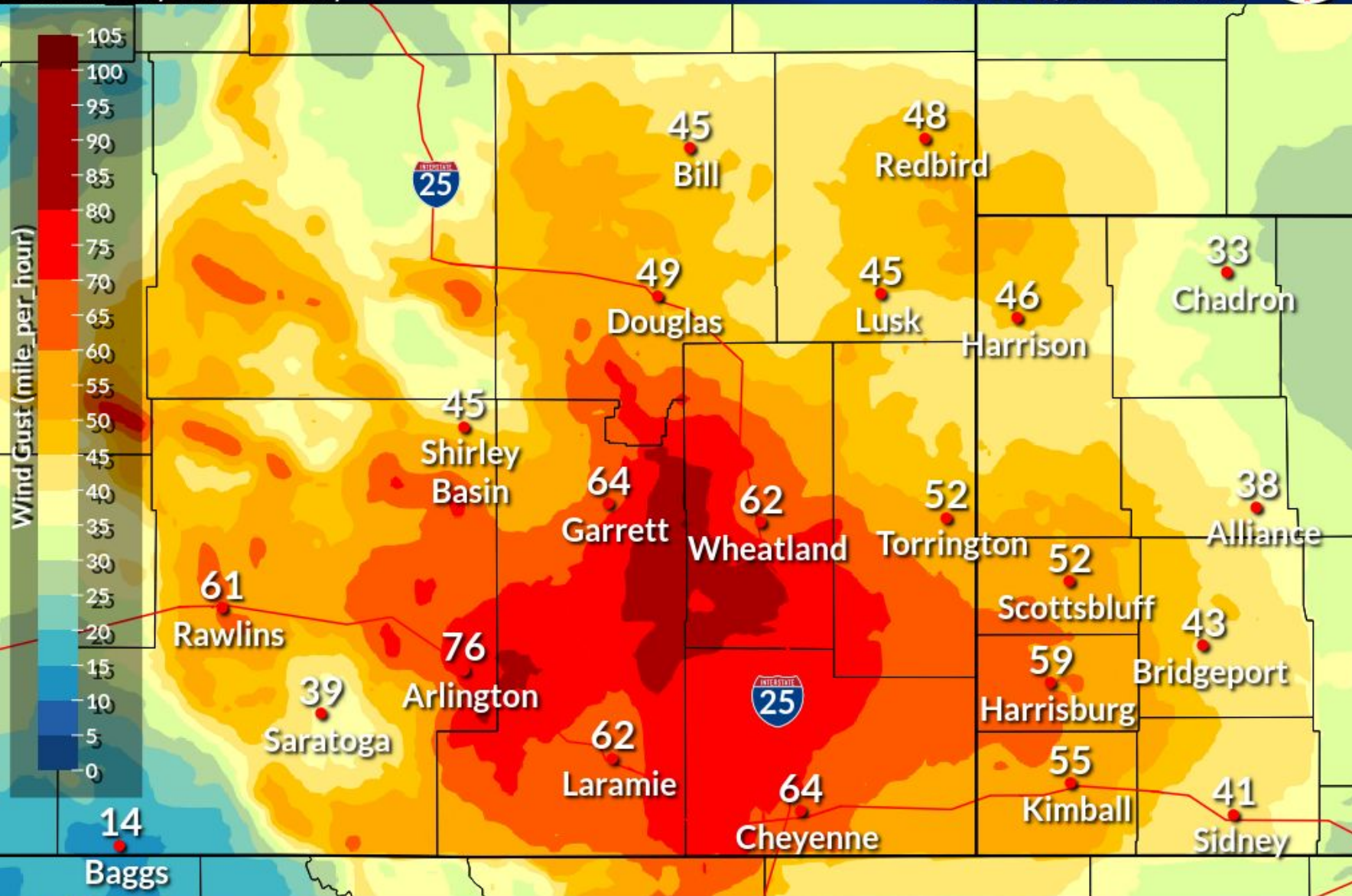

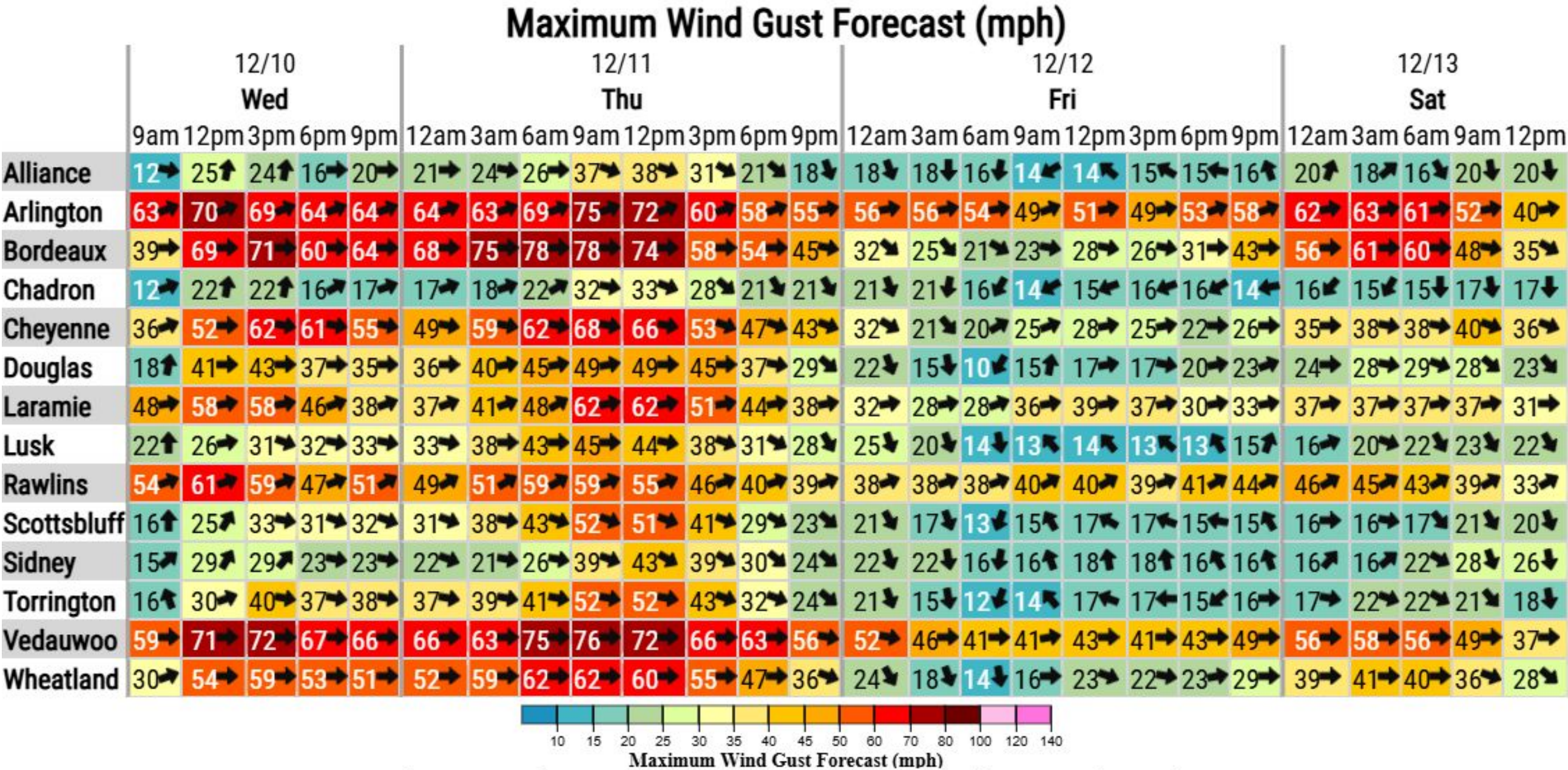
