
Widespread Accumulating Snow Expected Through Tonight

## Bottom Line


- Total Snow Accumulations: **2-5 inches** North, **1-4 inches** South
- **Timing: through Early Tuesday Morning**
- Wind Chills tonight as low as the **teens to low 20s**


## What to Expect

Snow is moving in from the west late this afternoon to evening ... snow falls across all of the region tonight


Bands of heavier snow will lead to snowfall varying by 1-2" within counties

## Level of Impact

Travel delays for evening rush hour possible, and continue through the evening across Central Indiana




# Central Indiana Wind Chill Timeline

Sub-freezing Wind Chills continue ... with single digits Wed Night, Thu Night

## Minimum Wind Chill Forecast (°F)



Created: 3 pm EST Mon 12/1/2025 | Values are minimums over the period beginning at the time shown.

## Winds

- Wind chills in teens at night...20s during day through Wednesday
- Blustery at times Wednesday night into Friday morning with wind chills at night around **zero to 15°F**

## Actions to Take

- Wear multiple layers
- Take breaks from the cold air in sheltered areas
- Make sure your house has been winterized

# WINTER KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

## Check road conditions.

Call 511 or visit your state's DOT webpage to check on road conditions. Choose a different route or adjust your travel plans if road conditions are poor.

## Pack an emergency supply kit.

Stock your vehicle with a mobile phone, charger, batteries, blankets, flashlight, first-aid kit, high-calorie, non-perishable food, candle to melt snow for drinking water, sack of sand or cat litter for traction, shovel, scraper, and battery booster cables.

## Get the weather forecast.


Change your travel plans if hazardous weather is expected.



## Ready your vehicle.

Check your battery, wipers, coolant, and other systems affected by cold temperature. Make sure your tires have good tread. Clear snow, ice or dirt from your windows, lights and camera.
