Key Messages:

- **Cold Weather Advisory** remains in effect through 10 AM Monday.
- Criteria is reached when temperatures and/or wind chills fall to 0° to -5° .
- A warming trend is forecast to begin Monday and continue into mid-week.

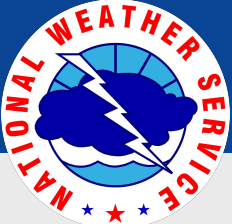




