



# Cold Temperatures Continue Tonight



Single Digit Temperatures Expected Across Central Kentucky and Southern Indiana

## Key Messages

- High pressure moves over the region tonight, with light winds and clear skies expected.
- Temperatures will fall steadily through the night, with low temperatures Monday morning expected to be in the single digits above zero in most locations.
- Areas with deeper snow cover are more likely to drop to around zero.
- Mostly sunny skies Monday will allow temperatures to return to the upper 20s and low-to-mid 30s.

## Key Messages

- Temperatures will gradually warm through the week.
- Dry weather is expected Monday and Tuesday.
- A low chance for rain showers returns Wednesday, particularly in southern Kentucky.
- Widespread gusty rain showers and possibly a few storms are expected ahead of a cold front on Thursday.
