Snow in Central Wisconsin, Wintry Mix to Rain in Southern Wisconsin

Bottom Line Up Front

- All snow expected in central WI
- In far southern WI, will likely see multiple precip type transitions: Mainly rain through midnight, then freezing rain and snow overnight, then back to snow by early Wed morning

NEW

Important Updates

- Slightly colder temps & further shift south
- Regardless of air temperature, icing is expected on untreated roads

Impacts:



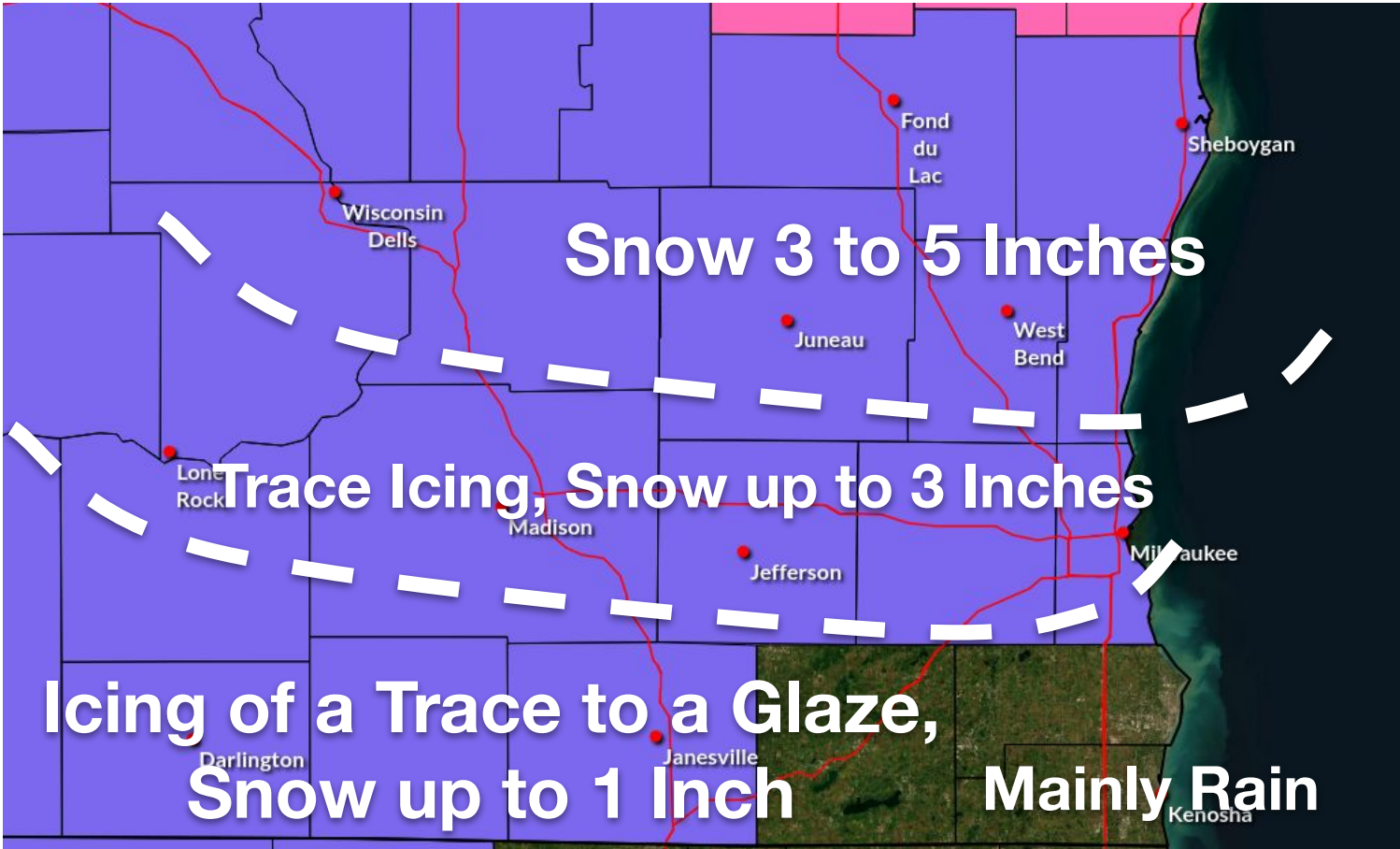
Slippery untreated roadways in the south, accumulating snow on roads in central WI

Precip Type Timeline

	Snow & Wintry Mix 7 PM - 2 AM CST Snow to wintry mix and rain in the south, all snow toward central WI; cold road temperatures continue as air temperatures warm	Snow 3 - 6 AM CST All temperatures fall and any wintry mix turns to snow	Snow Showers 6 - 11 AM Scattered snow showers linger through the morning

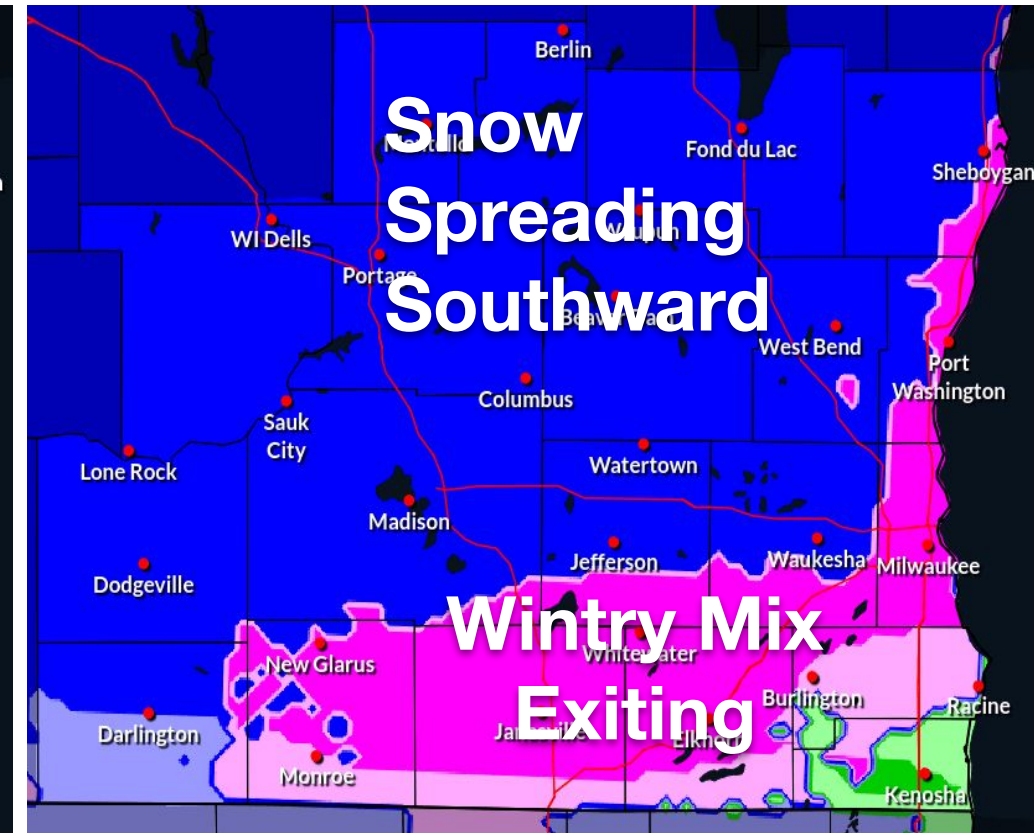

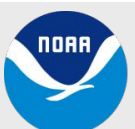

- Temperatures will rise through the overnight hours across southern WI, leading to freezing rain transitioning to rain.
 - Road temperatures remain below freezing, resulting in icy untreated surfaces even in areas with rain overnight.
- Temperatures will fall rapidly as a cold front moves through early Wed morning, bringing a return to all snow.
- Snow showers will then continue through much of Wed morning, but with minimal additional accumulations.

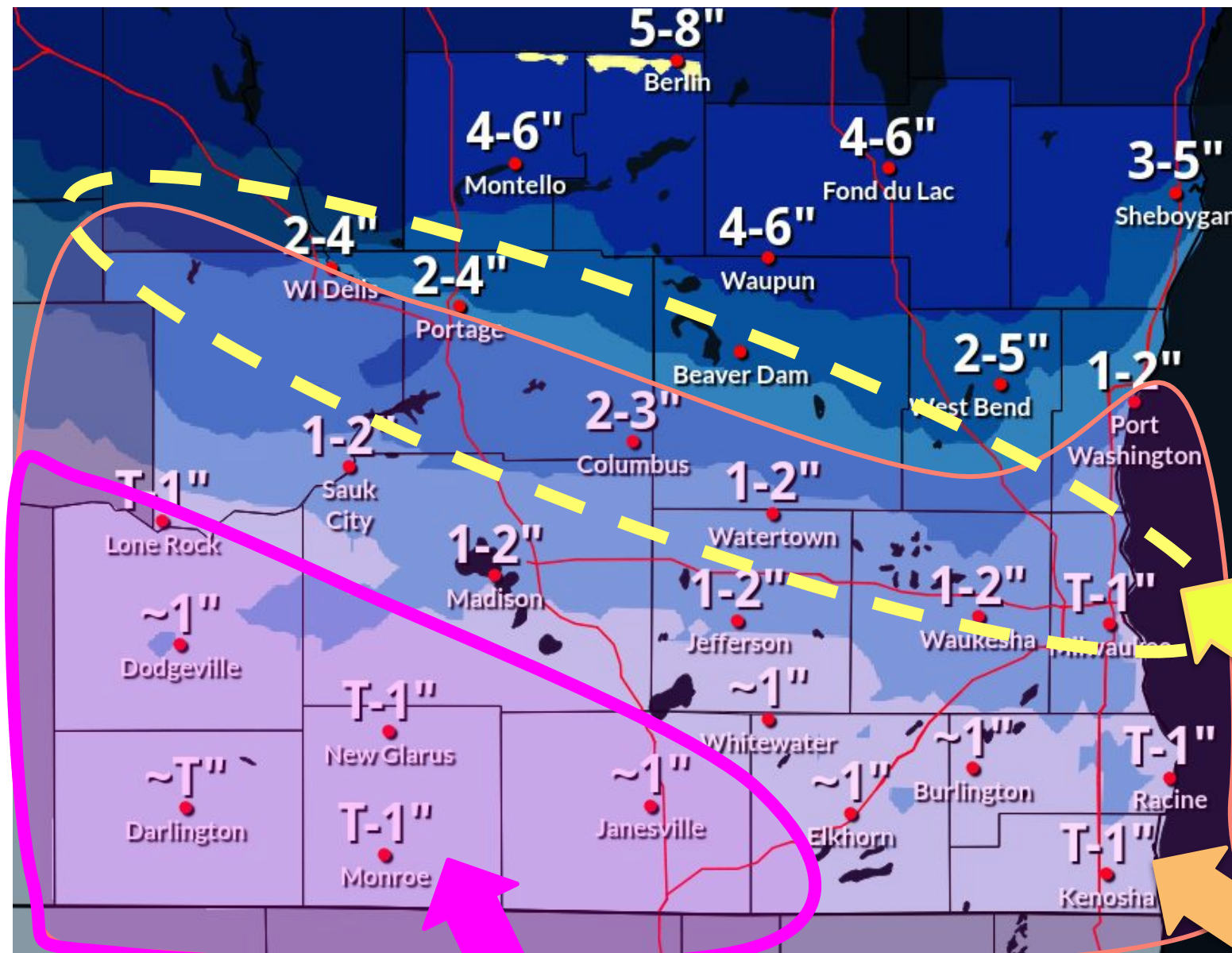


Precipitation Type & Snow Accums

This Evening Through Wednesday Morning

Expected Snowfall and Icing



- Total snowfall will be highest in central WI, with generally 3 to 5 inches expected, with a few spots seeing locally higher
 - Snowfall up to 1 inch in southwest WI
 - Snowfall up to 3 inches along the I-90/I-94 corridor
- Total icing will be highest in the southwest, with up to a glaze of ice accretions
 - Mixed precipitation will occur at times across the I-90/I-94 corridor

Update: Snowfall Amounts Increased by around 2"

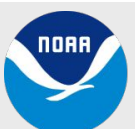
